STUDY QUESTIONS

Monday

1. What was the problem with the request of James and John's mother?
2. Read Genesis chapter 3:1-7. What similarities do you see between the desire of Adam and Eve and the desire of the disciples here in Matthew 20?
3. Read Philippians 2:5-9. Describe the path to true exaltation as exemplified by Jesus in these verses.

Tuesday

1. Look up the following passages and consider the model of leadership described in them. Gen. 18:22-26, 32:32, Josh. 24:14-15, Ruth 1:16-18, Neh. 4:1-11, and Phil. 2:25-30.
2. How might the principles of leadership described by Jesus here and exemplified in the passages above change the way you lead in the following areas?
 - Husband
 - Parent
 - Church member/leader

Wednesday Read and Meditate on Matthew 20:29–34

Thursday

1. Where is Jesus? Where is He going? Where is He coming from? (see the beginning of Matt 19)
2. How did the blind men address Christ? What does that reveal about who they thought Christ was?

Friday

1. What season was it? (which Jewish holiday is coming?)
2. Read Deut 16:16 – How big was the crowd?
3. Had Christ healed the blind before? (See Matt 9:27–31)

Saturday

1. Consider the scene Christ was in. The noise, the crowds cheering, the blind men yelling and the crowd yelling back. How did Jesus hear the blind men? How did he avoid missing these men?
2. What kind of hope do you have knowing that Christ noticed the blind men? Pray and thank God for knowing you and your needs.
3. How do the events of chapter 20 fit together? Is there a unifying theme?
